

Care content (cc) label reattachment process guide

HOW TO ATTACH CARE CONTENT LABELS


All labels are to be applied to garments using a single needle straight stitch machine. Operators must back tack. (Same application methods and placements apply for Men's, Women's, and Children's styles)

Bottoms Placement:

- Care Content labels are to be attached at the Centre Back waistband seam, unless otherwise indicated in the Specification Package.

Tops Placement:


- Care Content labels are to be attached at the Centre Back neck seam, unless otherwise indicated in the Specification Package.

INSIDE BACK VIEW




The completed work should look very close to a brand new garment with original cc labels. Exact thread color matching is not needed; please select the best option: black, white or grey.

The inside of the garment:

Schedule A: cont'd

- 1) Thread Color requirements:
 - Use Black thread on: All dark colors like blues, purples, blacks, and dark patterns
 - Use White thread on: Bright colors, and patterns and pastels
 - Use Grey thread on: Neutral and earth tones
- 2) Care content reattachment requests will be sent & to be returned along with the hemming requests
Turnaround time is the same as hemming: stores – 3 days; showrooms – 7 days
Each garment will have:
 - Its own hemming/alteration slip
 - Its respective CC label pinned to the garment.
 - If a label is not attached, please return garment to store, with a brief explanatory note
- 3) Reattach the CC label using your straight stitch machine
- 4) Secure, remove, and/or trim any loose or excess threads before starting to sew.
Pin the label onto the appropriate location



- 5) Sew an inch in length over the cc label:
 - parallel to the seam
 - secure stitching by back tacking the beginning & end of the seam line
 - clip excess threads
